

Summary Annual Report 2001-02

2001 – 2002 marked the start of Chwarae Teg's tenth anniversary year, and gave us an excellent opportunity to reflect on and to celebrate the successes of women in Wales. We hosted numerous events throughout the country, raising awareness of equality issues amongst policy makers, young people, opinion formers, educators and many others. 2001 – 2002 also saw us take great strides forward with our business plan, achieving and indeed surpassing many of our targets. As well as successes, the past year has also brought new and exciting challenges and I wish to thank Chwarae Teg staff and board members for unfailingly rising to all these challenges.

Significant achievements during the year included:

Research: With funding from the Welsh Assembly Government we conducted research into the barriers facing women in the Welsh economy. This was a comparative report linked to a study undertaken by the WDA and EOC ten years

ago. The research was very well received and instrumental in moving forward the debate on equal opportunities in Wales.

Work-Life Balance:

Chwarae Teg was selected, by the Welsh Assembly Government, as the lead partner in this very important pan Wales initiative.

Care: Childcare remains a significant barrier to women participating fully in the economy. Chwarae Teg successfully helped establish Clybiau Plant Cymru Kids' Clubs, a new Welsh organisation supporting out of school childcare clubs. We also worked with partner organisations to give dependant care the prominence it rightly deserves.

Marketing and communication:

British Gas supported our attendance at all four party political conferences in Wales for the second year running. Our Annual Conference attracted 250 delegates and was supported by ELWa and North Wales Police. UNIFI continued to design and print the bi-annual Balance newsletter that is circulated to interested parties including members and staff.

Women's Enterprise Wales:

As part of the WDA Entrepreneurship Action Plan we developed this project to assist women across Wales thinking of starting their own businesses.

SME Equality Project:

Chwarae Teg continued to successfully administer the WDA project. The number of businesses we have worked with reached 800.

Lone Parents Venture: Again as part of the above plan and the Potentia project we started work with this group of under represented entrepreneurs.

Marketing and communication:

British Gas supported our attendance at all four party political conferences in Wales for the second year running. Our Annual Conference attracted 250 delegates and was supported by ELWa and North Wales Police. UNIFI continued to design and print the bi-annual Balance newsletter that is circulated to interested parties including members and staff.

Our tenth anniversary research shows that there are still many challenges and barriers facing women in Wales. Working together with partners Chwarae Teg will continue to play a key role in driving forward the role of women in the workplace over the coming decade. Looking forward to 2002 and beyond we will undertake our core work and intend to develop projects in the following areas:

Employment practices: we will develop the Work Life Balance initiative and continue to promote good employment practices.

Promoting women's enterprise:

Chwarae Teg will continue to support women or lone parents wanting to start their own businesses across Wales. We will pilot a micro-credit programme.

Education and training: challenging stereotyping will remain core to our work. We will consider the indications from our research in relation to the lifelong learning agenda in Wales.

Informing public policy: our links with Europe, Westminster and the National Assembly for Wales will be further developed and we will build our expertise in relation to women's economic development in Wales.

Adolygiad y Prif Weithredydd

Bu i ni gynnal nifer o ddigwyddiadau ledled y wlad, gan gynyddu ymwybyddiaeth o faterion cydraddoldeb ymmsg llunwyr polisiau, pobl ifanc, ffurfwyr safwyntiau, addysgwyr a llawer o bobl eraill.

Yn 2001 – 2002 hefyd, bu i ni gymryd canau breision iawn gyda'n cynllun busnes, gan gyrraedd ac, yn wir, ragori ar lawer o'n targedau. Yn ogystal â llwyddiannau, daeth y flwyddyn ddiwethaf hefyd â sialensiau newydd a chyffrous gyda hi a hoffwn ddiolch i staff ac aelodau bwrdd Chwarae Teg am wynebu'r sialensiau hyn yn ddi-feth.
